

## AMERICAN THYROID ASSOCIATION GUIDELINES FOR SHARED TRAINEE ROOMS

If you apply for shared room accommodations please note that by accepting the grant for complimentary shared room accommodations you have agreed to share a hotel room with another ATA Grant Trainee (of same or similar demographics) who is also attending the 86<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting of the ATA and E. Chester Ridgway Trainee Grant Program.

It goes without saying that the expectation of 2 adult roommates is a measure of respect and regard for the duration of your stay while you are taking part in the 86<sup>th</sup> Annual Meeting of the ATA.

The ATA offers the following guidelines for that that mutual respect and conscientious behavior:

•Keep **noise** at a level that does not interfere with the sleep and comfort of your roommate and eliminate noise completely by 11:00 pm.

- · Behave with **respect and consideration** towards your roommate.
- $\cdot\,$  Be mindful of personal or professional colleagues that join you in your room and limit to short periods of time and quiet conversation.
- The room is for the stay of you and your assigned roommate only.
- $\cdot$  No one else is permitted to share the room. Separate accommodations at your own cost must be secured for all family members, children, or friends.
- Respect your roommates' space, privacy and personal belongings.
